1. Purpose

This Proclamation formally affirms and places on record the private and internal nature of all Shield of Souls Assembly ("the Assembly") documents, records, communications, and activities, establishing clear notice of jurisdiction, confidentiality, and privacy to all recipients or reviewers.

2. Declaration of Private Status


- (a) All writings, minutes, resolutions, communications, and records generated by, for, or on behalf of the Assembly are designated as private and confidential, intended solely for the use of Members and those explicitly authorized by the Assembly.
- (b) No Assembly document, record, or communication is to be disclosed, published, copied, or otherwise shared outside the Assembly's authorized channels except by clear written consent of the Assembly or as otherwise provided by Assembly policy.

3. Notice of Internal Jurisdiction

- (a) The Assembly operates in accordance with natural and divine law, as a private, self-governing body wholly separate from statutory, corporate, municipal, state, or federal jurisdiction.
- (b) All Assembly business, decisions, and records are matters of private contract and trust among its Members and subject only to the Assembly's governance structures, procedures, and processes.
- (c) Receipt, reading, or possession of any Assembly document or record constitutes agreement to respect these terms and the Assembly's internal jurisdiction.
